What Goes in Curbside Recycling?



Same rules apply to all municipalities in Ocean County

Mixed materials (wax coated, foil, glitter), greasy, hygiene/sanitary products, thermal receipts

Cardboard



Please flatten your boxes
Do not tie or bundle

Empty, clean, & dry

**Hazardous waste or
pressurized cans are
NOT accepted curbside**
