PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Township of Lakewood in the County of Ocean, New Jersey is authorized to (A) undertake HVAC system upgrades at Lakewood High School, Oak Street School, Spruce Street School, Clifton Avenue School, Lakewood Middle School and E.G. Clarke School and roofing replacement and related repairs at Oak Street School, Spruce Street School, Clifton Avenue School and E.G. Clarke School and (B) spend and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$29,497,241 to finance the cost of such projects.

The State has agreed to provide debt service aid for the projects in the amount of 40% of eligible costs. The projects' eligible costs are \$29,371,401.

In addition, the Board of Education is authorized to issue not to exceed \$5,200,000 of bonds to refinance its outstanding lease purchase.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Board of Education is seeking voter approval to undertake various school improvement projects and to refinance its outstanding lease purchase agreement to achieve interest cost savings. These projects include:

- HVAC system upgrades at Lakewood High School, Oak Street School, Spruce Street School, Clifton Avenue School, Lakewood Middle School and E.G. Clarke School:
- · Roofing replacement and related repairs at Oak Street School, Spruce Street School, Clifton Avenue School and E.G. Clarke School; and
- The refinance of the Board's outstanding lease purchase agreement with the issuance of lower interest rate bonds.

The cost of the HVAC system upgrades and roofing projects shall not exceed \$29,497,241 and the amount of the refinance of the lease purchase shall not exceed \$5,200,000, all of which will be funded through the issuance of bonds of the school district.

The State has awarded aid to the HVAC system upgrades and roofing projects in the amount of 40% of the eligible costs. This State aid award reduces the taxpayers' share of the projects to 60% of the cost. This 40% State aid is only available to the school district if the referendum is approved.
