Total cubic yards of debris removed (inland): 5,994

Yesterday's Operations:

• Sediment removal continues in Smith Creek, Edgewater Marina and Raritan Yacht Club. Debris removal continues in Weehawken.

Forecasted Operations:

- Wednesday: Continue sediment removal in the Hudson Marinas, Raritan Yacht Club, and Smith Creek. Debris recovery continuing in Weehawken on the Hudson.
- Four-day outlook: In Zone 1, sediment removal will continue in Edgewater, Von Dohln Marinas on the Hudson River, and Smith Creek. Debris removal will continue in Weehawken. Sediment removal is occurring on Raritan Bay Yacht Club. Sediment

removal in Compton's Creek (Zone 2) is currently on hold due to an endangered species issues.

- Estimated hydrographic survey acres: 206
- Total targets identified: 2,535

- Total targets disqualified/below draft depth: 393

Yesterday's Operations:

• Debris and target removal crews worked in the Shrewsbury River, Kettle Creek, and Toms River. Debris removal operations focused on removing visible and floating debris, as well as searching for submerged debris and targets in Zones 3 and 4. Sediment removal operations continued in Zone 4, area 6 and Zone 4, area 5.

Forecasted Operations:

- Wednesday: Debris removal crews will continue working in the Navesink River, Manasquan River, Shrewsbury River, Silver Bay, and Long Beach Island. Sediment removal to continue in Zone 4, areas 5 and 6 and sand screening and stockpiling activities to continue at Brick Beach 3.
- Five-day outlook: Operations on the Manasquan to finish within the next few days. Target and debris recovery will continue in Zone 3 at Black Point Creek, Oceanic Bridge, Monmouth Beach Channel, and Rumson County Club Channel. Sediment removal to continue in Zone 4, areas 5 and 6.

- Target Identification/marking was performed at Bay Grids 8-13, 8-14, 8-15 and 8-17, (Zone 8); and Mystic Creek West, (Zone 9).
- Target and debris removal from Bay Grids 8-13, 8-14, 8-15, 8-17, Beach Haven West lagoons southern section and Mill Creek, (Zone 8); Mystic Creek West, (Zone 9); and Cape May Harbor, Stone Harbor, Avalon and Sea Isle areas, back bay areas of Grids 11-35-37, and Delaware Bay from Cohansey River to Salem River, (Zone 11).
- Side scan sonar was performed in Jenkins Sound, Genesis Bay, Great Sound and Skull Bay, (Zone 11).

Forecasted Operations:

- Wednesday:
 - Vessel recovery scheduled for Zone 10, (Zone 10).
 - o Target identification/marking will be conducted in Bay Grids 8-16, 8-20 and 8-21, (Zone 8); and Delaware River from Fortescue to West Creek, (Zone 11).
 - o Target and debris removal from Beach Haven West southern section lagoons and LBI areas, and Grids 8-3, 8-13, 8-14, 8-15, 8-16, 8-20, and 8-21, (Zone 8); Mystic Creek West, (Zone 9); and the lagoons in Avalon, (Zone 11).
 - Side scan sonar will be conducted in Bay Grids 8-6, 8-9, 8-11, Brant Beach Yacht Club and Sportsman's Marina on Long Beach Island, (Zone 8); and Great Sound, Stitles Sound, and Townsend Sound, (Zone 11).



• Four-day outlook:

- o Target identification/marking will continue in Bay Grids 8-16, 8-20 and 8-21, (Zone 8); and Delaware River from Fortescue to West Creek, (Zone 11).
- Target and debris removal will continue in Beach Haven West southern section lagoons and LBI areas, and Grids 8-3, 8-13, 8-14, 8-15, 8-16, 8-20, and 8-21, (Zone 8); Mystic Creek West, (Zone 9); and the lagoons in Avalon, (Zone 11).
- o Side scan sonar continuing in Zones 8 and 11.
