ORDERED that in accordance with R. 4:86-4(b) _____ Esq., an attorney-at-law of the State of New Jersey, is hereby appointed to represent the interests of _____, the Alleged Incapacitated Person, in these proceedings, and further, said attorney is to visit the alleged incapacitated person, personally serve him with a copy of the Complaint, supporting affidavits, and Notice of the Hearing, and is to verbally, if not in writing, report to this Court at the time set forth herein, at which time the Court will consider the need for interim relief and may execute the Order to Show Cause filed in these proceedings; and it is further

ORDERED that the Notice to the Alleged Incapacitated Person shall fully state that if he desires to oppose this action, he may appear at the Hearing either in person or by attorney, and if he desires a trial by jury, he may demand same; and it is further

ORDERED that all possible efforts are to be taken to notify interested parties set forth in R. 4:86-4(a), as well as other known family members, prior to the hearing to appoint a Temporary Guardian and plaintiff shall report such efforts to the Court at the hearing; and it is further,

ORDERED that this matter be set down for Hearing before the Honorable John A. Peterson, Jr., J.S.C., 118 Washington St., Court Room 2, Toms River, New Jersey on _____ at _____ a.m. or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, at which time this Court will consider the Complaint and Order to Show Cause filed herein and the need for the interim relief requested.
