WHEREAS, on March 29, 1973 combat and combat-support units withdrew completely from South Vietnam and returned home; and

WHEREAS, of the 2.7 million Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen and Marines that served, more than 58,000 were killed and more than 304,000 were wounded in action; including almost 45,000 New Jersey residents who served and nearly 1,500 that lost their lives; and

WHEREAS, called upon by their Country, these patriots did their duty and bore the horrors of battle in Vietnam, only to come home to shoulder the burden of an unpopular war that was no fault of their own; and

WHEREAS, these brave Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen and Marines who returned from Vietnam were never accorded the recognition and praise that was routinely given returning servicemen and women in earlier wars; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the sacrifices of these heroes who served during this difficult chapter in our Nation's history are remembered for generations to come, legislation was passed in the House and in the Senate to create the first Federal Statutes to both recognize Vietnam Veterans and create an Annual Recognition; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, President Trump signed the legislation into law thereby designating each March 29th as "National Vietnam War Veterans Day" vowing to honor all those who answered our Nation's call to duty and never again confuse personal disapproval of war with prejudice against those who honorably wear the uniform of our Armed Forces.

RESOLUTION March 21, 2018

- WHEREAS, the voters of Ocean County authorized the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Fund to provide funds for the acquisition and preservation of natural lands, open spaces and farmland; and
- WHEREAS, the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee was established by the Board of Chosen Freeholders to review nominations to the program and forward recommendations for acquisition to the Board of Chosen Freeholders; and
- WHEREAS, the Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee has received nominations for the properties identified as Block 16501, Lot 15 totaling approximately 71.31 acres located on Wilson Boulevard in Jackson Township; and
- WHEREAS, the property is located adjacent to over 2,200 acres of Natural Lands Trust Fund property; and
- WHEREAS, one professional appraiser appraisal was authorized to determine the fair market value; and
- WHEREAS, the Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee has determined the property's attributes are consistent with the Ocean County Open Space Plan and Recreation Inventory; and
- WHEREAS, this property is eligible for up to fifty (50) percent cost share from United States Department of Defense consistent with the agreement authorized by Board of Chosen Freeholders resolution dated May 16, 2012; and
- WHEREAS, the County of Ocean would acquire the property for a purchase price not to exceed \$260,000 of equivalent land value; and
- WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed acquisition was conducted by the Board of Chosen Freeholders on March 21, 2018 as required by PL 1997, c24.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY as follows:

- 1. It accepts the recommendation of the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee to participate in the acquisition of property identified as Block 16501, Lot 15 totaling approximately 71.31 acres located on Wilson Boulevard in Jackson Township.
- 2. It authorizes the expenditure for an acquisition price not to exceed \$260,000 plus up to \$1,500 for property tax adjustments as necessary from the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Fund, Account Number 225-155-0151.
- 3. It authorizes the Freeholder Director and Clerk of the Board to execute any agreements for additional funding and or partnerships made available for this purchase.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT

- 1. The proper officers of the Board are authorized and directed to sign all necessary documents in order to effectuate these purchases.
- 2. The purchase of the property is to be contingent upon the County's acquisition by purchase, deed or gift of the necessary rights-of-way along the County roads bordering the property as determined by the County Engineer.
- 3. It authorizes the Freeholder Director to execute any agreements for funding made available for this purchase from the United States Department of Defense.

WHEREAS, the property is adjacent to six farms preserved by Ocean County; and

WHEREAS, the property owner wishes to sell contingent upon deed restrictions imposed that prohibit both groundwater withdrawal and residential subdivision; and

WHEREAS, two professional appraisals have been completed to establish the fair market value of the property as if restricted; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee has determined the property's attributes are consistent with the Ocean County Open Space Plan and Recreation Inventory; and

WHEREAS, the County of Ocean would acquire the property for a purchase price not to exceed \$400,000 of equivalent land value; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed acquisition was conducted by the Board of Chosen Freeholders on March 21, 2018 as required by PL 1997, c24.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY as follows:
