








Fishing and Watersports




The LBI Ferry from Tuckerton Seaport to Beach Haven



The US Navy established Naval Air Station Lakehurst back in 1921, and it became known as the "Airship Capital of the World"! Today, "Naval Support Activity Lakehurst" is part of a magnificent joint military installation called Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst. In the early days of its rich, 100-year history, Lakehurst hosted helium-filled dirigibles which traversed the Atlantic, many of

them carrying distinguished tourists from Europe to the US in the 1920's and 30's. The most famous airship, the Hindenburg, was destroyed in flames upon approach to Lakehurst in May of 1936. This story and more vibrant military history can be explored at the Navy Lakehurst Historical Society's Heritage Center located on base in Hangar One.















Ocean County is proud to be the home of Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst,

which spans more than 40,000 acres across two counties here in central NJ. This unique and vibrant military installation has a rich history in the region and is the second largest employer in the State. With a \$7 billion economic impact on NJ, Joint Base MDL supports missions and training for the Air Force, Army, Navy, Marines, Coast Guard, Guard and Reserve. As their neighbors, we strive to enhance the quality of life for our military community, their families and the civilian personnel who work and live on this incredible installation. The Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Program was established in 1997 as a way to preserve the natural beauty of Ocean County, and protect our watershed. By preserving open space we have established over 25,900 acres of land for public use. Our visitors enjoy many activities from kayaking along the bay, to hiking miles of trail, or hunting on over 13,000 acres

Among these are two public courses maintained by the Department of Parks and Recreation. Forge Pond Golf Course was ranked in the top 20 public golf courses to play in NJ by Golf Advisor. Atlantis Golf Course is a much longer course than Forge Pond but to some golf enthusiasts is one of the best layouts in the state of NJ.


