# IMPORTANT! ATTENTION VOTERS! NEW IN-PERSON-EARLY VOTING IS AN OPTION - STARTS SAT. OCT 23 THRU SUN. OCT 31

As a result of legislation enacted into law this year the State of New Jersey will be offering in-person early voting a nine day period. In addition to providing early voting, registered voters will continue to have the option of voting by mail or in-person at their polling place on Election Day. Below is a sample copy of the ballot that will appear on the new voting machines at the 10 early voting sites throughout Ocean County. New electronic poll books will be used to sign-in voters. Poll workers will be available to assist all voters in using these new devices. The early voting locations are listed below. Hours for early voting are Monday-Saturday, 10am to 8pm and Sunday 10am to 6pm. It doesn't matter where you live in Ocean County - registered voters can go to any of the 10 sites and conveniently cast your ballot on a voting machine.

### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

THE DISTRICT'S GROWTH AND EXPANSION OVER THE YEARS, ALONG WITH FEDERAL AND STATE MANDATED UPGRADES, HAS CREATED THE NEED FOR MORE TECHNOLOGICALLY ADVANCED EMERGENCY RESPONSE UNITS. THE PROPOSED PURCHASE SHALL MEET THE NEEDS OF THE RESIDENCES, BUSINESSES AND PROPERTY OWNERS WITHIN THE DISTRICT AND LEGISLATIVE MANDATES. THE PROPOSED TOWER LADDER FIRE APPARATUS WILL REPLACE A TWELVE (12) YEAR OLD TOWER LADDER FIRE APPARATUS WHICH HAS BECOME OBSOLETE. THE ONE (1) FIRE APPARATUS REPLACED WILL BE SOLD OR TRADED IN TO OFFSET THE COST OF THE PROPOSED PROCUREMENT. THE PROJECT AS PROPOSED IS ANTICIPATED TO HAVE A MINIMAL IMPACT ON THE TAX RATE.
