FO VOTING

Press the button to the right of the candidate of your choice; a green "X" will appear next to your selection.

To change a selection, press the button again. The green "X" will disappear and you may make a new selection.

If you wish to cast a WRITE-IN vote, go to the PERSONAL CHOICE column and press the button next to WRITE-IN across from the office you wish to write-in. A blinking green "X" will appear. Using the alphabetical keyboard below, enter the name of the person of your choice, one letter at a time. To make a space between first and middle name or initial and last name use the arrow pointing to the right on the keyboard. To make a correction, use the arrow pointing to the left. The name you enter will appear in the display to the left of the keyboard. When you have entered the whole name, proof it, then press the ENTER button on the keyboard. Your choice is recorded and removed from the display. Do not press the Cast Vote Button until all other choices are complete. (Each write-in is a separate entry.)

WARNING! An improperly cast write-in vote will be deemed void. Be sure that your write-in vote is cast in the PERSONAL CHOICE column on the same line as the office for which you are casting the write-in vote.

- To vote on the PUBLIC QUESTIONS press the button to the right of the word "YES" or "NO"; a green "X" will appear next to your selection.
- After ALL selections have been made, press the RED CAST VOTE BUTTON located in the lower right corner. 5 This electronically records all of your votes.
- Part the curtains and exit the voting booth.

| V JERSEY | LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION BOND |

Do you approve the "New Jersey Library Construction Bond Act"? This bond act authorizes the State to issue bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$125 million. The proceeds of the bonds will be used to provide grants to public libraries. The grants will be used to build, equip, and expand public libraries to increase capacity and serve the public.

Approval of this bond act will allow the State to sell \$125 million in State general obligation bonds. Proceeds from the bonds will be used to provide grants to construct, expand, and equip public libraries. Municipalities or counties that fund public libraries will match the grant amount. The municipality or county may solicit private funding to support its match. The State Librarian, in consultation with the President of Thomas Edison State University, will set eligibility criteria for the grants.

LOCAL QUESTION NO. 1 NEW ACT Shall the Borough of Beach Haven establish an annual levy at the rate of \$0.01 per \$100.00 of assessed value of real property located in the Borough and annually appropriate that revenue for any or all of the following purposes, or any combination thereof: INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT a. acquisition of lands for recreation and conservation purposes b. development of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes; c. maintenance of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes; historic preservation of historic properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas, or objects, and the acquisition of such properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas, or objects for historic preservation purposes; or e. payment of debt service on indebtedness issued or incurred by the Borough for any of the purposes set forth in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), or (d) herein above? INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT A "yes" vote on this question would allow the Borough of Beach Haven to establish a "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, **STATE QUESTION NO. 2** and Historic Preservation Trust Fund" to be funded annually through the collection of a dedicated open space tax in the CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT DEDICATING MONEYS FROM STATE ENVIRONMENTAL CONTAMINATION CASES amount of one cent per one hundred dollars of assessed value. This tax would be dedicated to the maintenance, improvement or acquisition of land for recreation and conservation purposes, and the acquisition and preservation of historic properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas, or objects, or for payment of debt service or indebtedness issued or incurred by the Borough for any of these purposes. Approval may also enhance the Borough's ability to qualify for NJ State Green Acres funds under the Planning Incentive Acquisition Program and enable the Borough to qualify for any future programs, presently not in existence, which might condition a municipality's eligibility to receive open space funds on the adoption of a tax levy INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT and the creation of a "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund." This amendment would dedicate moneys collected by the State relating to natural resource damages through settlements A "no" vote means that you do not support annually funding a "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund" through the collection of a dedicated open space tax in the amount of one cent per one hundred dollars of assessed value.

Do you approve amending the Constitution to dedicate all moneys collected by the State relating to natural resource damages in cases of contamination of the environment? The moneys would have to be used to repair, restore, replace, or preserve the State's natural resources. The moneys may also be used to pay legal or other costs incurred by the State in pursuing its claims.

or awards for legal claims based on environmental contamination. These moneys would be dedicated to repair, replace, or restore damaged natural resources, or to preserve the State's natural resources. The moneys would be spent in an area as close as possible to the geographical area in which the damage occurred. The moneys could also be used to pay for the State's legal or other costs in pursuing the claims. Currently, these moneys may be used for any State purpose.
