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NORTHERN REGION:

To Date:

• Total cubic yards of debris removed (inland): 6,432

Total number of large debris recovered: 38 vessels

• Total verified sediment removal (total cubic yards): 43,291

Total verified acres surveyed by side scan sonar: 32,988

• Estimated hydrographic survey acres: 177

Yesterday's Operations:

• Sediment removal continues in Smiths Creek and Edgewater Marina. Debris removal continues in Weehawken.

Forecasted Operations:

- Saturday: Continue sediment removal in the Hudson marinas and Smiths Creek. Debris recovery is continuing in Weehawken on the Hudson.
- Four-day outlook: In Zone 1, sediment removal will continue in Edgewater, Von Dohln marinas on the Hudson River, and Smiths Creek. Debris removal will continue in Weehawken. Sediment removal in Compton's Creek (Zone 2) is currently on hold due to an endangered species issues.

Yesterday's Operations:

• Debris and target removal crews worked in the Shrewsbury River, Kettle Creek, Beaver Creek, and Toms River. Debris removal operations focused on removing visible and floating debris, as well as searching for submerged debris and targets in Zones 3 and 4. Sediment removal and sand screening operations continued in Zone 4, area 6. Sediment removal operations in Zone 4, area 5 are suspended until Zone 4, area 6 operations are completed.

Forecasted Operations:

- Saturday: Debris removal crews will continue working in the Navesink River, Manasquan River, Shrewsbury River, Silver Bay, and Long Beach Island. Sediment removal, sand screening and stockpiling activities to continue in Zone 4, area 6.
- Five-day outlook: Debris removal operations on the Manasquan to finish within the next few days. Target and debris recovery will continue in Zone 3 at Black Point Creek, Oceanic Bridge, Monmouth Beach Channel, and Rumson County Club Channel. Sediment removal and sand stockpiling at Brick Beach 3 to continue in Zone 4, area 6.

Yesterday's Operations:

- Land-based debris removal from Sea Isle City East Point Road to Maurice River, (Zone 11).
- Target identification/marking was performed in Bay Grid 8-25, (Zone 8); Bay Grids 9-1, 9-2, 9-5, 9-6, 9-7, 9-11, (Zone 9); and Delaware Bay from Pierce's Point to Cape May, (Zone 11).
- Target and debris removal from Bay Grid 8-25, Beach Haven West Ship Bottom to end of Beach Haven, (Zone 8); Mystic Island East, (Zone 9); and Grids 11-25-31, (Zone 11).
- Side scan sonar was performed in Bay Grids 8-6, 8-9, 8-11, and 8-24 (Zone 8); and Townsend Sound and Stiles Sound, (Zone 11).
- Vessel recovery was conducted in Galloway, (Zone 10); and Cedar Creek, (Zone 11).

Forecasted Operations:

- Saturday:
 - No work planned for Zone 10.
 - Target and debris removal from Beach Haven West lagoon, Ship Bottom, Beach Haven Terrace, Beach Haven Gardens and Bay Grid 8-100, (Zone 8); Tuckerton Green, Grids 9-2, 9-3, 9-11 and 9-12, (Zone 9); and Ocean City lagoons, Ventnor, and Delaware River from West Creek to Artificial Island, (Zone 11).
 - o Side scan sonar will be conducted in Bay Grids 8-19, 8-23 and 8-24, (Zone 8).
- Four-day outlook:
 - Target and debris removal will continue in Beach Haven West lagoon, Ship Bottom, Beach Haven Terrace, Beach Haven Gardens and Bay Grid 8-100, (Zone 8);
 Tuckerton Green, Grids 9-2, 9-3, 9-11 and 9-12, (Zone 9); and Ocean City lagoons, Ventnor, and Delaware River from West Creek to Artificial Island, (Zone 11).
 - Side scan sonar continuing in Zone 8.
