 Sediment removal continued in Smiths Creek. Target removal will continue in Newark Bay.

Forecasted Operations:

- Tuesday: Sediment removal will continue in Smiths Creek. Target removal will be completed in Newark Bay. Hydrographic surveys will take place in the marinas of Gateway and Captain's Cove.
- Four-day outlook: Sediment removal will continue in Smiths Creek and a hydrographic survey will be scheduled for Raritan Bay Yacht Club.

Yesterday's Operations:

• Debris removal crews worked in the Rumson and Kettle Creek areas in Zone 3 and 4 removing debris. Sediment removal and sand screening operations continued in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove.

Forecasted Operations:

- Tuesday: Debris removal crews are working to remove debris in the Rumson area in Zone 3. Sediment removal and sand screening operations to continue in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove.
- Five-day outlook: Debris operations have achieved substantial completion and contractor will continue to respond to new debris sighting reports. Sediment removal and sand screening operations to continue in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove. Beach quality sand is being relocated to Brick Beach and beaches near Downer and Lyman Street. Sediment removal operations to begin in Zone 5 within the week.
