PICNICKING

Ocean County Park provides reservable picnic areas for groups from 25 to 600 people. Reservations begin on March 1st and must be made at least three weeks before the desired date. Reservation fees are reasonable and beer and wine permits are available at an additional cost. Charcoal grills are provided and propane grills are not permitted. The picnic area is open April 1st to November 1st.
