Maximum volume per household is limited to 200 pounds of dry materials and 20 gallons of liquid.

Please, no containers larger than 5 gallons.

Unacceptable Materials: radioactive materials, dioxins, infectious waste ("Red Bag" wastes), explosives, unknown or unidentified materials.




