

Other Recycling Opportunities at the County's Recycling Centers . . .

Batteries Automobile batteries and household batteries (carbon, alkaline, button, or other types of dry cell batteries).



Waste Oil & Antifreeze



Waste oil that does not contain gas, water, or antifreeze accepted at a five-gallon limit. Waste oil is not accepted from commercial establishments.

Antifreeze accepted from residents at a five-gallon limit.

Tires



Automobile and light truck tires accepted for a fee of \$1.00 per tire. Up to twenty tires per day are accepted. Centers accept tires no larger than a truck tire and no smaller than a 13" tire. Bicycle, motorcycle, or racing tires are not accepted.

Phone Books



Clean, outdated phone books accepted year round.

Cell Phones



Cell phones accepted in unlimited quantities. Also accepted at *The County Connection* in the Ocean County Mall.

Computers



Monitors, central processing units, expansion boards, printers, scanners, keyboards, mice, cables, speakers, laptops, and laptop peripherals.

Appliances



Appliances without Freon or having had their Freon removed are accepted by municipalities.

Fluorescent Bulb



Residents only can drop off a Maximum of five 4, 6, & 8 foot fluorescent lamps or u-shaped, circular and compact fluorescents during regular business hours. **Broken**

Fluorescent Lamps are not accepted. These fixtures are also accepted during the County's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program.

More Info . . .

Leaves, Brush, and other Vegetative Waste



Unbagged leaves and light brush accepted at both Recycling Centers. Brush must be 4" in diameter or less. Christmas trees are accepted at both Centers during the holiday season.

Subject to capacity limitations, fresh cut grass is accepted only at the Northern Recycling Center.

Household Hazardous Waste



Toxic household products such as herbicides, pesticides, household cleaners, paints and paint thinners, solvent and photographic chemicals accepted on Household Hazardous Waste Collection days in the spring and fall of each year.

Pre-registration is required. Call the Ocean County Solid Waste Management Hotline at **1-800-55-RECYCLE**. Dry materials limited to 200 pounds. Liquid materials limited to 20 gallons.

Paint



Full, partially full, and empty paint cans are accepted at the County's Recycling Centers & certain municipal locations. There is a 20 can limit through the Ocean County Paint Management Program. Latex, oil based, and boat paints are accepted. No stains or wood preservatives are accepted.



Residents can recycle Boat Shrink Wrap at the County's Recycling Centers during regular business hours and also at municipal recycling centers at **Berkeley Twp., Brick Twp., Lacey Twp., Little Egg Harbor Twp., Tuckerton Borough, Ocean Twp., Pt. Pleasant Borough, and Toms River Twp.**
