Curbside Recycling Guide

(Revised 2020)

ACCEPTED



- Plastic Bottles and Jars (Neck smaller than base)
 - 2. Glass bottles and jars



3. Cans: Aluminum, steel, and tin; CLEAN aluminum foil

Empty and rinse - Remove caps, lids, and pumps







- 4. Mixed Paper Magazines, catalogs, junk mail, envelopes, office paper, newspapers, paper bags, construction paper, books (without hardcover).
 - 5. Corrugated cardboard boxes Clean Pizza boxes

Flatten all cardboard boxes

Keep materials loose and free, do not tie or bundle.

NOT ACCEPTED

- · Chipboard or grayboard (cereal boxes, beverage carriers, gift boxes, toilet paper rolls).
- SHREDDED PAPER (Recycling Center drop-off).
- Telephone Books (Recycling Center drop-off).
- · Paper plates, cups, napkins, tablecloths, etc.
- Plastic utensils, cups, food containers or lids (yogurt tubs, microwave trays, deli trays, etc.).
- Plastic flower trays, shrubbery pots, or garden hoses.
- BOTTLE CAPS AND JAR LIDS (PLASTIC OR METAL).
- Soft plastics (shopping bags, plastic film, 6-pack holders, etc.) (drop off at Participating Stores).
- · Cartons (milk, juice, etc.), waxed paper or waxed cardboard containers (aseptic packaging).
- File folders, stickers or address label sheet waste.
- Food-contaminated aluminum foil, aluminum throw-away pans or deli trays.
- Rigid Plastics (laundry baskets, garbage cans, lawn furniture, totes, etc.) (Recycling Center drop-off).
- PVC pipe/tubing, plastic, metal drums or 5-gallon water bottles.
- Glass plates/cups, window glass, mirrors, ceramics cookware, pots & pans.
- Aerosol paint cans, lubricants, gas, motor oil, or other hazardous materials (bring to HHW Events).
- Light Bulbs.
- · Styrofoam.
- Scrap Metal.

NO PLASTICS OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED AS ACCEPTED.
