NORTHERN REGION:

To Date:

• Total cubic yards of debris removed (inland): 1,912.2

Today's Operations:

• No survey work was performed today due to high winds. Floating and partially submerged debris recovery continued in Matawan Creek (~100 cubic yards)

Forecasted Operations:

- Side scan sonar surveys will be performed on the Hudson River and Raritan Bay along the coastline and in the bay area.
- Debris recovery will continue in the Matawan Creek.
- Sunday: Side scan sonar surveys in the Hudson River and Raritan Bay.
- Monday: Side scan sonar surveys in the Hudson River, tributaries of the Arthur Kill, and Raritan Bay. Debris recovery in Cheesequake Creek.
- Further into next week: Target removal in the Hudson River and upper Hackensack River.

- Total large debris (vessels, cars, etc.): 10 vessels, 3 vehicles
- Total verified acres surveyed by side-scan sonar: 7,803.1

Today's Operations:

• Work suspended in all zones due to weather.

Forecasted Operations:

- Recovery of visible, floating, and targeted debris will continue in Toms River and west of Lavallette and Seaside Heights.
- Side scan sonar surveys will continue west of the State Park.
- Sunday forward: Side scan sonar operations will continue in Zone 6. Debris recovery will progress in an area from the Forked River to the Barnegat Bay inlet.
