PUBLIC QUESTIONS TO BE VOTED UPON

BOND PROPOSAL NO. 1

The Board of Education of the Long Beach Island Consolidated School District in the County of Ocean, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to provide for the construction of an addition consisting of classrooms, a gymnasium and offices to the Ethel Jacobsen Elementary School; (b) to acquire the necessary equipment and undertake any associated site work; (c) to appropriate \$14,579,176 for such improvements; and (d) to issue bonds of the School District in the principal amount of \$14,579,176.

The final eligible costs of the improvements approved by the Commissioner of Education are \$291,720. The proposed improvements include \$3,569,280 for school construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). Proceeds received by the Board of Education from the sale of the Long Beach Island Grade School either shall be used to pay direct costs of the project and to reduce the bond authorization or shall be transferred to the debt service fund to pay principal of obligations issued under this bond proposal. The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the project. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this special election.

BOND PROPOSAL NO. 2

(Bond Proposal No. 2 will only go into effect if Bond Proposal No. 1 is approved by the voters at this election.)

The Board of Education of the Long Beach Island Consolidated School District in the County of Ocean, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to undertake renovations, alterations and improvements to the Ethel Jacobsen Elementary School; (b) to acquire the necessary equipment and undertake any associated site work; (c) to appropriate \$3,774,235 for such improvements; and (d) to issue bonds of the School District in the principal amount of \$3,774,235.

The final eligible costs of the improvements approved by the Commissioner of Education are \$3,774,235. The proposed improvements include \$0 for school construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). Proceeds received by the Board of Education from the sale of the Long Beach Island Grade School either shall be used to pay direct costs of the project and to reduce the bond authorization or shall be transferred to the debt service fund to pay principal of obligations issued under the bond proposals approved at this election. The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the project. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this special election.

INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT

If both Bond Proposals are approved, the total cost of the improvements will be \$18,353,411 and will be financed with School District bonds in the amount of \$18,353,411. The final eligible costs of the improvements approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education for both Bond Proposals are \$4,065,955. The proposed improvements include \$3,569,280 for school construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). Proceeds received by the Board of Education from the sale of the Long Beach Island Grade School either shall be used to pay direct costs of the projects and to reduce the bond authorization or shall be transferred to the debt service fund to pay principal of obligations issued under this bond proposal. The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects approved at this election.
