OMLS is a provider of free legal services to low-income residents of Ocean and Monmouth Counties. Thanks to grants from the Robin Hood Relief Fund and our statewide agency, Legal Services of New Jersey, OMLS can expand its eligibility criteria to assist victims of Superstorm Sandy with their legal issues. Eligible applicant's income must be under 250% of poverty (<\$28,725 for a household of 1), with deductions allowed for certain storm related expenses.
