 Debris removal crews worked in the Kettle Creek and Rumson areas in Zones 3 and 4 removing debris. Sediment removal and sand screening operations continued in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove.

### Forecasted Operations:

- Saturday: Debris removal crews are working to remove debris in the Kettle Creek and Rumson areas. Sediment removal and sand screening operations to continue in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove.
- Five-day outlook: Debris operations have achieved substantial completion and contractor will continue to respond to new debris sighting reports. Sediment removal and sand screening operations to continue in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove. Beach quality sand is being relocated to Brick Beach and beaches near Downer and Lyman Street. Zone 5 dredging operations are scheduled to start within the week.
