## Special Extended Hours & Deadlines for Nov. General Election

The County Clerk and the Board of Elections will offer extended weekend office hours on Saturday, November 3rd and Sunday, November 4th to accommodate voters who are unable to apply and obtain a ballot in person during regular business hours.



From 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., Saturday, Nov. 3rd, and Sunday, Nov. 4th, staff from the County Clerk's Office and the Board of Elections will assist registered voters in casting a ballot at the Board of Elections Office located in the basement of 129 Hooper Ave., Toms River. Free parking is available in the Ocean County Parking Garage adjacent to the Board of Elections office.

The deadline for all applications for Vote by Mail Ballots for the Nov. 6th General Election that are sent through the mail is October 30th. After that date, registered voters in Ocean County must apply in person to obtain a Vote by Mail Ballot. Voters do not need a reason to use the Vote by Mail option in New Jersey.

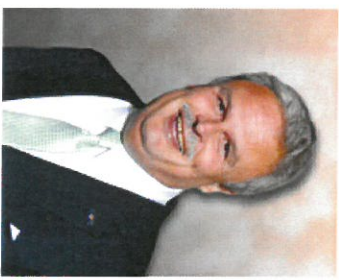
The deadline for obtaining a Vote by Mail Ballot in person is 3 p.m., Monday, Nov. 5. After 3 p.m. Monday, voters must obtain a court order from a Judge allowing them to apply for a Vote by Mail Ballot. Official Voting Machine Sample Ballots will be mailed to registered voters and the Sample Ballots are also available to view online at [www.oceancountyclerk.com](http://www.oceancountyclerk.com) on our web page.
