• Sediment removal took place in the DOT Channel of Smiths Creek and Gateway Marina. Debris removal took place in the Elizabeth area.

- Tuesday: Sediment removal will continue in the DOT Channel of Smiths Creek and Gateway Marina. Debris removal will take place in the Elizabeth area.
- Four-day outlook: Sediment removal will continue in Smiths Creek, Gateway Marina, and Captain's Cove Marina. The contractor will continue to respond to new debris sighting reports.

 Debris removal crews worked in the Metedeconk, Lavallette, and Island Beach State Park area removing debris. Sediment removal and sand screening operations continued in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove.

- Tuesday: Debris removal crews are working to remove debris in Zones 4 and 7. Sediment removal and sand screening operations to continue in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove.
- Five-day outlook: Debris operations have achieved substantial completion and contractor will continue to respond to new debris sighting reports. Sediment removal and sand screening operations to continue in Zone 4 and Trader's Cove. Beach quality sand is being relocated to Brick Beach and Mantoloking on Lyman Street.
