

Transportation

- The district of origin must pay incurred transportation costs to the district in which the child is being educated.
- When a homeless student attends school in the district of origin while living outside the district, the district of origin must provide for the student's transportation to and from school immediately, without delay.
- The State reimburses transportation costs for homeless students included on the ASSA, not via separate billing as with tuition reimbursement.
- Districts should develop safe and cost-effective methods for transporting homeless students and give consideration to special circumstances.
- Transportation for homeless students should be set up immediately and without delay at the time of enrollment. Enrollment means attending classes and participating fully in school activities.
