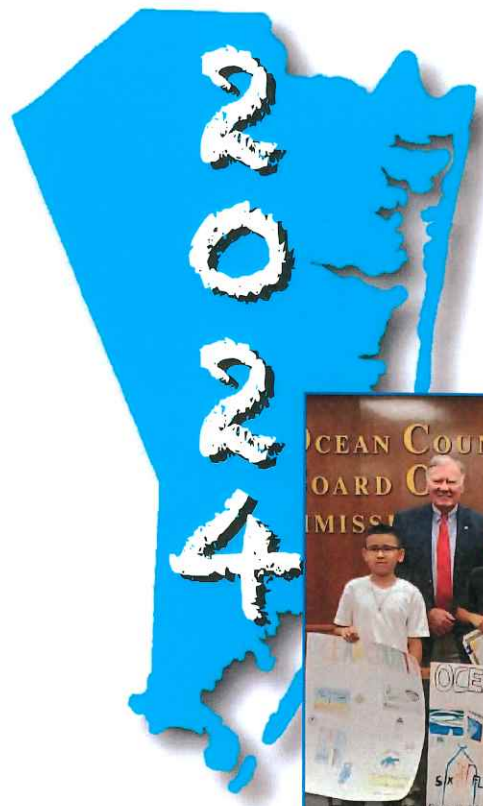

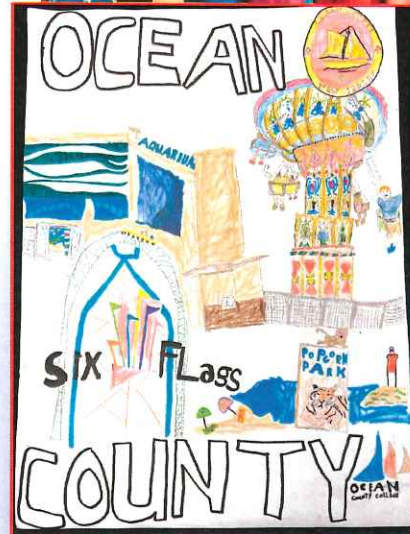

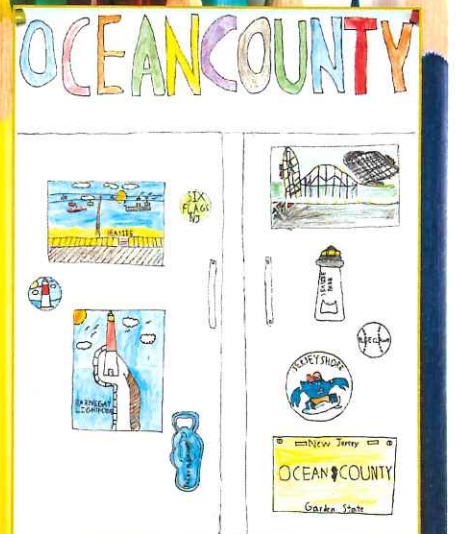

A Poster Contest for Fourth Graders In Recognition of National County Government Month

THE RULES:

- ★ Each Fourth Grade Class must select one Student's Poster as the winner to represent their class in the Contest.
Only one Poster per Class can be entered in the Contest.
- ★ The Poster must be on standard 22" X 28" White Poster Board.
- ★ The name of Ocean County must be in 4-inch letters formed in black marker at the top of the Poster.
- ★ The Student's Name, Teacher's Name & School must be printed neatly in the lower right hand corner on the back of the Poster.

Not everyone is aware that County Government in New Jersey is responsible for County road maintenance, jails, mortgage & deed recording, voting procedures, parks, consumer affairs, and lots more. To commemorate National County Government Month occurring this April & to promote awareness of the work accomplished throughout New Jersey's 21 Counties, the Ocean County Clerk is sponsoring a poster contest called "My County." Fourth graders are invited to design a poster for the contest. Design & content of the poster are at the discretion of the student. Special knowledge or background is not needed. Four top posters will be selected by the public by casting a vote for a favorite poster on the County Clerk's Facebook page. The winners will receive a plaque and be invited to meet County Officials in Toms River. All posters become the property of the County of Ocean. Submission of the posters grants the County Clerk permission to display in public places.
