# Celebrating our 175th Anniversary of Ocean County Poster Contest for 5th and 6th grade students

### General Rules and Regulations

- 1. The contest is open to all 5th or 6th grade students, residing or attending school in Ocean County.
- 2. Theme: Please design a poster based off of the following prompt:
- "As we celebrate the 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our county, take a moment to think about what makes Ocean County a great place to live! Show us your favorite locations, local landmarks, activities, and/or foods that make Ocean County a special place to be a kid!"
- 3. **Only one submission** <u>per school</u> <u>will be submitted.</u> All 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders in Ocean County can create a poster if they wish. Each class will vote on 1 poster to send forward as representative of their class. Posters should be judged by the Principal of the school to choose the best from that selection. Each school will send **one poster to enter the contest** as representative of their school.
- 4. Only one submission per school will be accepted.
- 5. The poster image must be attached to an email submitted to <a href="kkosa@co.ocean.nj.us">kkosa@co.ocean.nj.us</a> no later than 5PM on November 1, 2025. Principals will attach a high quality jpeg, at least 2 mgs/600 dpi; in the file name, include the name of the school and township the entry is from. Your subject line should read: "175th Anniversary of Ocean County Poster Contest Submission"; in the body of the email, include the Principal's name, phone number where we can reach you during the school day, and a direct contact email. The student's contact information/release form should also be attached to the email. <a href="We cannot accept any submissions">We cannot accept any submissions for the poster selected from your school without this form.
- 6. Posters must be completed on a 22"x 28" piece of poster board. Any drawing medium may be used.
- 7. Posters will be judged by panel on the following categories: Creativity and Originality, Connection to the theme, Artistic Quality, and Impact and Message.
- 8. By virtue of submission, the participant gives permission to the Ocean County Board of Commissioners to publish the work on the respective County Facebook pages for public voting for the contest. A judging panel will narrow down the submission to the top 10 choices, and those 10 posters will be posted on the respective County Facebook pages for public voting for a maximum of FOUR days. Winners will be determined by the number of votes received: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes will be awarded.
- 9. Prizes are as follows: Gift Certificates to Blick Art Materials in the amounts of: \$175 for 1st place, \$100 for 2nd place, \$75 for 3rd place. Winners will receive notice if they won by email. They will be invited to receive their prize at a future Ocean County Board of Commissioners meeting, to be determined. All winners will be asked to participate in a reception at a later time to celebrate their accomplishments, to be announced. Please bring your poster to both events.
- 10. Terms and conditions subject to change without notice.
- 11. Decision of judges is final.
