ORDINANCE #2018-17

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RENOVATIONS, REPAIRS AND UPGRADES TO THE 129 HOOPER AVENUE BUILDING, LOCATED IN TOMS RIVER TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AND APPROPRIATING \$1,500,000 THEREFOR, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,425,000 IN BONDS OR BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE COUNTY OF OCEAN TO FINANCE THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY (NOT LESS THAN TWO THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF AFFIRMATIVELY CONCURRING) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the County of Ocean as

general improvements: renovations, repairs and upgrades to the 129 Hooper Avenue Building, located in Toms

River Township, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, including, but not limited to, construction, design and

permitting and all else necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the improvements or purposes, the

estimated cost of the improvements and appropriation therefor, down payment and estimated maximum amount

of bonds or notes authorized are as follows:

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SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,500,000, including the sum of \$75,000 as the down payment, for the improvements or purposes described in Section 1 hereof as required by the Local Bond Law. The down payment has been made available by virtue of provision in the Capital Improvement Fund of the County of Ocean in one or more previously adopted budgets.

SECTION 4. There is hereby authorized the issuance of negotiable bonds in an aggregate principal amount of \$1,425,000 to finance part of the cost of the purposes stated in Section I hereof. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding the limit authorized by law, and the maturities, method of sale and other details thereof shall be determined by subsequent resolutions to be adopted in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 5. In order to temporarily finance the purposes provided for in Section 1 hereof, there is hereby authorized the issuance of bond anticipation notes of said County in an aggregate principal amount of \$1,425,000. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the County Comptroller; provided that no note shall mature later than one year from its date. The bond anticipation notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and shall be in such form as may be determined by the

County Comptroller. The County Comptroller shall determine all matters in connection with notes issued pursuant to this Ordinance, and the County Comptroller's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-8.1. The County Comptroller is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The County Comptroller is directed to report in writing to the Board of Chosen Freeholders at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the notes pursuant to this Ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

SECTION 6. The County reasonably expects to commence acquisition and/or construction of the improvements described in Section 1 hereof, and to advance all or a portion of the costs in respect thereof, prior to the issuance of bonds or notes hereunder. To the extent such costs are advanced, the County further reasonably expects to reimburse such expenditures from the proceeds of the bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance, in an aggregate amount not to exceed the amount of bonds or notes authorized in Section 2 hereof. This bond ordinance is intended to be a declaration of official intent under Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2.

SECTION 7. Any grant monies received for the purposes described in Section 1 hereof, shall be applied either to direct payment of the cost of the improvements or to payment of the obligations issued pursuant to this bond ordinance. The amount of obligations authorized but not issued hereunder shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are so used.

SECTION 8. The amount of the proceeds of the obligations authorized by this Ordinance which may be used for the payment of interest on such obligations, architects' fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses, and other items as provided in N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 shall not exceed the sum of \$1,000,000.

SECTION 9. The Capital Budget of the County of Ocean is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders and is available there for public inspection.

SECTION 10. It is hereby found, determined and declared as follows:

A. The improvements or purposes described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance are not current expenses. They are improvements or purposes the County may lawfully undertake as general improvements,

and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property benefitted thereby.

B. The average period of usefulness of the improvements for which the obligations authorized by this Ordinance are to be issued is fifteen (15) years.

C. The supplemental debt statement provided for in N.J.S.A. 40A:2-10 was duly filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders prior to the passage of this Ordinance on first reading, and a complete executed duplicate of such supplemental debt statement has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey, and such supplemental debt statement shows that the gross debt of the County as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:2-43 is increased by this Ordinance by \$1,425,000 and the obligations authorized by this Ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

SECTION 11. In the event the monies set forth above for any purpose is not necessary for said purposes, then such monies shall be for the completion of any of the other purposes provided for in this Ordinance.

SECTION 12. The full faith and credit of the County of Ocean shall be pledged to the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds and notes authorized by this Ordinance, and as long as any of said bonds or notes are outstanding, an appropriation shall be included in each annual budget of the County hereafter adopted in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds or notes maturing in each year. The obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the County, and the County shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the County for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation as to rate or amount.

SECTION 13. After passage upon first reading of this Ordinance, the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders is hereby directed to publish the full text of the Ordinance, together with the notice set forth below entitled: "NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE" (with appropriate completions, insertions and corrections), at least once in a newspaper qualified under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-19, at least seven days prior to the date set for public hearing and further consideration for final passage (which date shall be at least ten days after introduction and first reading). The Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders is further directed to comply with all provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-17(b) regarding postings, publications, and the provision of copies of this Ordinance.

SECTION 14. After final adoption of this Ordinance by the Board of Chosen Freeholders, the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders is hereby directed to publish the full text of this Ordinance, as finally adopted, together with the notice set forth below entitled: "NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE" (with appropriate completions, insertions and corrections), at least once in a newspaper qualified under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-19.

SECTION 15. The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County hereby covenants on behalf of the

County to take any action necessary or refrain from taking such action in order to preserve the tax-exempt status of the bonds and notes authorized hereunder as is or may be required under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder (the "Code"), including compliance with the Code with regard to the use, expenditure, investment, timely reporting and rebate of investment earnings as may be required thereunder.

SECTION 16. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

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ORDINANCE #2018-18

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ACQUISITION OF LAND FOR A SOCIAL SERVICES FACILITY, DESIGN, ENGINEERING AND PERMITTING, LOCATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF TOMS RIVER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AND APPROPRIATING \$7,000,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$6,650,000 IN BONDS OR BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE COUNTY OF OCEAN TO FINANCE THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY (NOT LESS THAN TWO THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF AFFIRMATIVELY CONCURRING) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the County of Ocean as general improvements, acquisition of land known as Block 608, Lot 19, portions of Lot 16-2, Lot 18 and Lot 18-1, all as designated on the official tax map of the Township of Toms River, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, for a Social Services Facility, including design, engineering and permitting and all else necessary therefor and

incidental thereto.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the improvements or purposes, the

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$7,000,000 including the sum of \$350,000 as the down payment, for the improvements or purposes described in Section 1 hereof as required by the Local Bond Law. The down payment has been made available by virtue of provision in the Capital Improvement Fund of the County of Ocean in one or more previously adopted budgets.

SECTION 4. There is hereby authorized the issuance of negotiable bonds in an aggregate principal amount of \$6,650,000 to finance part of the costs of the purposes stated in Section 1 hereof. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding the limit authorized by law, and the maturities, method of sale and other details thereof shall be determined by subsequent resolutions to be adopted in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 5. In order to temporarily finance the purposes provided for in Section 1 hereof, there is hereby authorized the issuance of bond anticipation notes of said County in an aggregate principal amount of \$6,650,000. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by

the County Comptroller; provided that no note shall mature later than one year from its date. The bond anticipation notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and shall be in such form as may be determined by the County Comptroller. The County Comptroller shall determine all matters in connection with notes issued pursuant to this Ordinance, and the County Comptroller's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-8.1. The County Comptroller is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The County Comptroller is directed to report in writing to the Board of Chosen Freeholders at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the notes pursuant to this Ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

SECTION 6. The County reasonably expects to commence acquisition and/or construction of the improvements described in Section 1 hereof, and to advance all or a portion of the costs in respect thereof, prior to the issuance of bonds or notes hereunder. To the extent such costs are advanced, the County further reasonably expects to reimburse such expenditures from the proceeds of the bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance, in an aggregate amount not to exceed the amount of bonds or notes authorized in Section 2 hereof. This bond ordinance is intended to be a declaration of official intent under Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2.

SECTION 7. Any grant monies received for the purposes described in Section 1 hereof, shall be applied either to direct payment of the cost of the improvements or to payment of the obligations issued pursuant to this bond ordinance. The amount of obligations authorized but not issued hereunder shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are so used.

SECTION 8. The amount of the proceeds of the obligations authorized by this Ordinance which may be used for the payment of interest on such obligations, architects' fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses, and other items as provided in N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 shall not exceed the sum of \$3,500,000.

SECTION 9. The Capital Budget of the County of Ocean is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders and is available there for public inspection.

SECTION 10. It is hereby found, determined and declared as follows:

A. The improvements or purposes described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance are not current expenses. They are improvements or purposes the County may lawfully undertake as general improvements, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property benefitted thereby.

B. The average period of usefulness of the improvements for which the obligations authorized by this Ordinance are to be issued is forty (40) years.

C. The supplemental debt statement provided for in N.J.S.A. 40A:2-10 was duly filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders prior to the passage of this Ordinance on first reading, and a complete executed duplicate of such supplemental debt statement has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey, and such supplemental debt statement shows that the gross debt of the County as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:2-43 is increased by this Ordinance by \$6,650,000. and the obligations authorized by this Ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Freeholder Director Gerry P. Little opened the meeting at 4:06 PM and read the Statement of Compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act. The Clerk of the Board called the roll.

Freeholder Director Little opened the meeting.

Mr. Ernst reviewed the items listed on the attached Engineering Department agenda, which included a Resolution authorizing a 60 foot distance of Mill Street located in South Toms River to be discontinued as a County Road and jurisdiction returned to the Borough of South Toms River. Mr. Ernst stated there were three additional routine miscellaneous items included on the Agenda. There were no additional comments and all items will be listed on the Board Agenda for the June 6, 2018 Board meeting.

Members of the Board of Chosen Freeholders May 31, 2018 Summary of the Pre-Board meeting of May 30, 2018 Page 2

Planning Director Tony Agliata spoke about a Natural Lands Trust Acquisition located at Block 3401 lots 66 and 67 in Jackson Township. The Francis Mills Park Extension consists of 22.9 acres of wooded uplands and wetlands, which could support 4 single family homes if developed. The accepted offer is \$450,000.00, which is well below the asking price of \$550,000.00 and the appraised value of \$500,000.00.

Freeholder Director Little discussed the 50th Anniversary of National Trail Day. Ocean County is planning a special event in Waretown to mark the National Trail System Act, set forth by President Johnson in 1968, at the Barnegat Branch Trail between Country Lane and Railroad Avenue this Saturday, June 2, 2018 from 10am – 2pm. Freeholder Haines will be representing the Board at the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony at 10am. There is an outdoor exercise area near Railroad Avenue where the County will provide a personal trainer to teach children how to use the equipment properly. There will be Ocean County Park Naturalists on hand to discuss the various plants indigenous to the area. The County will also be providing bicycle helmets to children in need. Freeholder Director Little commended Donna Flynn on her efforts in putting this event together.

Freeholder Vicari spoke about the importance of the \$4.8 billion tourism industry in Ocean County. Ocean County is ranked 3rd in the state in regards to tourism revenue, behind Cape May and Atlantic Counties. Freeholder said he encourages seasonal businesses to come to Ocean County because the residents benefit from the tourist dollar as well. Freeholder mentioned that many people own second homes in the County and pay their taxes but have no schoolchildren to utilize the funding.

Freeholder Vicari also discussed his interest in signing new State legislation for the New Jersey Motion Picture and Television Commission, as well as starting a five member subcommittee here in the County.

Tourism Director Dana Lancellotti discussed the new tourism website, and the new theme for this year which is "Escape the Ordinary". The Ocean County television commercial was made by producers from Long Beach Island featuring a campaign that runs from Virginia to Montreal in print, on the radio, and in a USA Today ad as well. Ms. Lancellotti also discussed the County Facebook page, which includes a wealth of information regarding the current and next week's local area events. These events are also "shared" on other NJ tourist websites as well. Ms. Lancellotti demonstrated the ease of using the County website. The events calendar has an expansive list of local happenings with links to the appropriate County Departments. There are maps on the site that include directions to various events. The County magazine is distributed from Virginia to New York at hotels, bus stops, rest areas and travel shows, and include information for discounts to beaches and parks for military families as well.

Ms. Lancellotti also mentioned the importance of tourism grants to the County. They are approved in April and 25 local businesses received a portion of \$60,000.00 this year, some receiving as much as \$7500.00. Freeholder Haines commended Dana on the County commercial and her presentation.

Freeholder Vicari discussed the 21st season of the County Pump Out Boat Program which consists of six County vessels that are specially equipped to empty the on board toilets and tanks of other boats, thus keeping waste from entering the bay. This is a free service offered to boaters covered by the Clean Vessels Act. A reference card is available showing each of the location sites. The boats can be accessed by contacting the captains on VHF radio and their cell phone numbers are provided as well.

Freeholder Director Little mentioned that these pump out boats can also be an extra set of eyes out on the water in case a boat is in distress.

Ms. Vasil reviewed the Clerk of the Board's Agenda for the Board meeting of June 6, 2018. There were no questions or comments.

Freeholder Director Little asked the Board members for comments.

There were no additional comments.

Ms. Vasil read the resolution to move to closed session.
