- Advise the County Mental Health Board and the NJ Department of Children and Families in planning for mental and behavioral health services for children
- Provide the County with a multidisciplinary forum to review and discuss the system of services for children with special social, emotional, and behavioral challenges
- Identify and address barriers to effective service delivery
- Seek solutions for the County and make appropriate recommendations on programs and policies that impact children and families

...through a partnership of parents, consumers, government, community-based organizations and service providers.

The ultimate goal of the CIACC's activities is to oversee mental and behavioral health services available to children and families to ensure that the appropriate and least restrictive level of care is obtained and that a comprehensive system of needed services within the County is maintained.

This preserves the integrity of treatment and saves public funds through diverting unnecessary out-of-home placements.

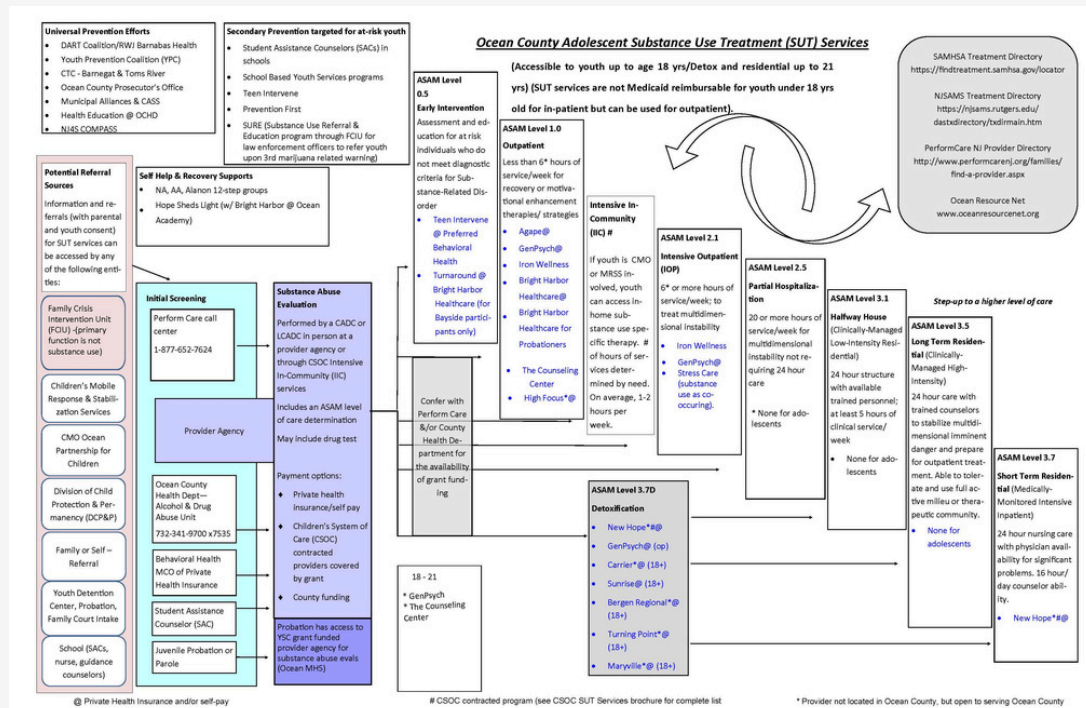
