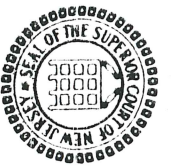

First, you will see the wall treatment which included fluted columns with a circular effect at the top as well as the type of framed panels which we saw in the pictures of Courtroom One. The bench also appears to be a black walnut or dark mahogany effect with some raised paneling. Unfortunately, I could not copy the original photograph very well. However, I can show it to you or your historian when you are next at the courthouse.
