The student contact information/release form should also be attached to the email. <u>We cannot accept any submissions without this form.</u>
- 5. Essays will be judged by panel on the following categories: Clarity and Organization, Depth of Insight, Historical Accuracy, Creativity, and Writing Quality.
- **6.** By virtue of submission, the participant gives permission to the Ocean County Board of Commissioners to publish the work (including but not limited to) the respective County Facebook pages for publicity once chosen for a prize. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes will be awarded.
