Director Vicari opened the meeting by introducing Nicole Sabarese of ReMax Real Estate in Toms River, and David Wyrsch of Van Dyke Realty in Long Beach Island and Manahawkin who discussed the housing situation in Ocean County. There is a lack of available housing because the interest rate has increased to around 7%. Homeowners are mainly staying in their homes and utilizing equity unless it is completely necessary to move. The prices of rent have also increased quite a bit due to the lack of homes available for purchase.

Commissioner Quinn discussed the County's need to purchase a 26-acre firearms practice range facility in Little Egg Harbor. There are approximately 1600 County law enforcement officers that need to qualify yearly who will utilize the facility. Municipalities will be using the practice range for a fee. The large parking lot area may also be used as a staging area for law enforcement in the event of an emergency. Letters in support of the purchase have been received by many municipal police departments, as well as the Police Chiefs Association, the Sheriff's Department and Prosecutors Office. The Ordinance was introduced at the Board meeting on December 6, 2023, and the Public Hearing will be held on December 20, 2023. The County expects to close on the property in late January 2024.
