The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Sustainable Waste Management, Bureau of Planning and Licensing is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Ocean County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated September 22, 2022. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion to increase Suffolk Recycling Corp.'s (Suffolk) Class B allowable incoming tons per day (tpd) from its current limit of 600 tpd to 1,500 tpd located at Block 12, Lots 35, 39, 40, and 41) in the Borough of South Toms River.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)4, a one-time capacity increase over the operational life of any size, other than that specified at N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.10 (b)8 and (b) 10, for any regulated solid waste facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion for Suffolk's increase in tons per day is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Ocean County has received a request from Resource Management Associates on behalf of Suffolk Recycling Corp. ("Suffolk"), a Class B recycling center located in the Borough of South Toms River (*Block 12, Lots 35, 39, 40, & 41*), to amend the Ocean County District Solid Waste Management Plan. The requested amendment would increase Suffolk's allowable incoming tons per day (TPD) from its current limit of 600 TPD to 1,500 TPD. Occasional large loads anticipated necessitate this change.

This modification is acceptable to the County, and may be accomplished via Administrative Action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6:11(b)4. This letter shall serve to modify the Ocean County District Solid Waste Management Plan and incorporate an increase in Suffolk's allowable incoming TPD, subject to the Department's approval.

On behalf of Suffolk Recycling Corp. ("Suffolk") and as agent for same, I hereby submit the information contained within as a request to amend their current General Class B recycling center approval (for concrete and asphalt materials). This request is made to amend their existing Ocean County Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) inclusion as a Class B recycling center.

The requested amendment to increase the incoming tons per day (tpd) limit from its current limit of 600 tpd to 1,500 tpd. Occasional large loads anticipated to be received have necessitated this change at this time. No other aspects of their current Class B approval are requested to be modified; in particular, no additional processing rates, storage capacities, etc. are requested for modification (only the incoming tpd).

This existing General Class B recycling center has, and continues to be, approved to receive, process, store and transfer concrete, asphalt, brick, and block materials. No change is requested in materials to continue to be received.

Please note that I have copied the NJDEP Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste, Bureau of Landfill and Recycling Management to inform them of this requested amendment to the SWMP inclusion of Suffolk Recycling Corp., and upon approval of this request from the County we will make a formal General Class B recycling center modification application to that office.

Please advise me if you require any further information, or how the County will be proceeding in this matter. Should you require a formal presentation before the SWAC, please advise so that we may schedule this at your earliest possible convenience.
