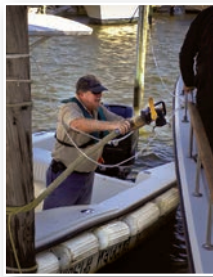
The pumpout boats operate weekends from Memorial Day through early October, typically from 9:00AM to 5:00PM.

- **Over 2 million gallons of effluent** have been removed from recreational vessels since the 1st boat began operations...that could otherwise have ended up in the Bay!
- **COVID-19 procedures for pumpouts**
The captains are practicing no-contact pumpouts: maintaining 6 feet distance, passing the nozzle to the boater with the boat hook and disinfecting after each use. Please be patient... and stay safe.
