NOTICE OF APPLICATION

IN THE MATTER OF: FOUR SEASONS COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

Application No. 2470P to divert water from 40 existing and 1 proposed well in Lakewood Township, Ocean County.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, DIVISION OF WATER SUPPLY & GEOSCIENCE, TRENTON, NEW JERSEY. Pursuant to the provisions of the Water Supply Management Act, N.J.S.A. 58:1A et seq., FOUR SEASONS COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, 1560 Spring Meadow Drive, Lakewood, New Jersey, 08701, filed an application on March 11, 2020 for approval of plans to divert 27 million gallons of water per month (MGM) and 97.5 million gallons of water per year (MGY), at a maximum rate of 1750 gallons per minute (GPM) from 40 existing and 1 previously unpermitted well, 100 to 150 feet deep completed in the Kirkwood-Cohansey Formation. This request represents the addition of one well and no increase in allocation. The wells are located in Lakewood Township, Ocean County off of Spring Meadow Drive. The diversion is to be used for irrigation of the community and golf course.

Any person or interested party may request that a public hearing be scheduled regarding this application. Comments, including the request for the public hearing, must be submitted in writing. All comments must be received no later than 30 days from the publication date of this notice and submitted to:

Upon completion of its review, the Department will make a final determination in the matter and the conditions to be contained within the permit, if issued.
