This year-long process will involve a canvassing of a broad range of Ocean County residents and groups. The Ocean County Cultural Plan (2002-2007), a comprehensive, broad-based "roadmap" created to address the county's cultural needs and resources, has served as a basis for actions driving the county's cultural growth and development over the past seven years. The implementation of key goals, strategies and objectives from the plan has resulted in strengthened resources for the cultural and greater community. Artists, historians, cultural nonprofit organizations and especially the future generation face a vastly different "cultural landscape" than seven years ago, when the first plan was initiated. New challenges and opportunities have arisen for everyone, and now more than ever is a crucial time to re-assess and gather resources, and focus on creating new visions which reflect the present and anticipated cultural needs and offerings of our community. The Ocean County Cultural & Heritage Commission will be celebrating its 40th anniversary this fall with a ceremony at the Pine Barrens Jamboree at Wells Mills County Park in Waretown, on Saturday, October 10, 2009.
