The United States Navy dirigible USS Shenandoah was built in 1923 at Lakehurst Naval Air Station and first flew on September 4, 1923. After many crossing of North America, on its 57th flight, the USS Shenandoah crashed in Ohio in 1925 due to bad weather.

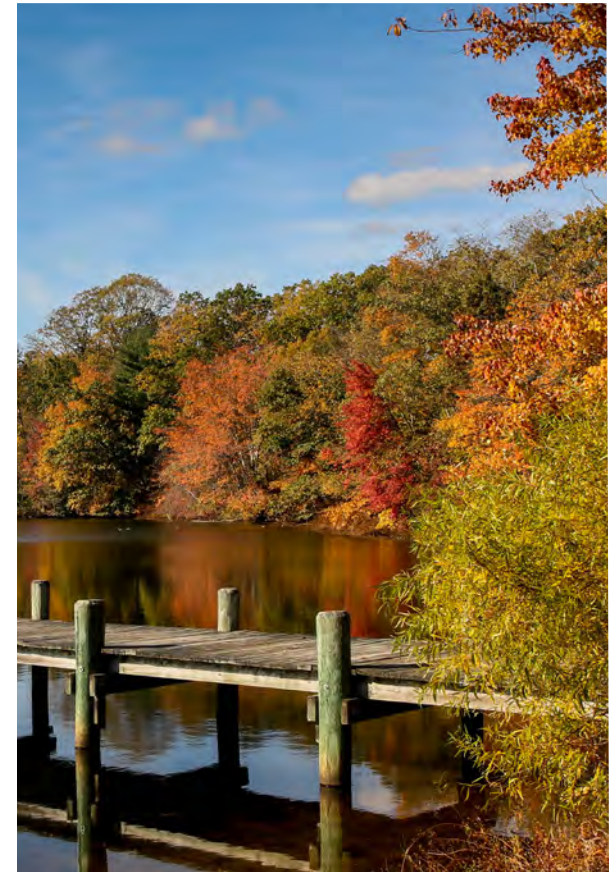
